Seaforth Huron Harvest is a collaborative project coordinated by five Seaforth service clubs. Working together to help improve the lives of people in Seaforth and Huron County is the reason behind Huron Harvest. The Seaforth Lions Club, Optimist Club, Curling Club, Agricultural Society and Royal Canadian Branch 156 are presenting this social event as a fundraiser for the Huron Residential Hospice.

Seaforth Huron Harvest is a tasting event that highlights locally produced food, beer, cider, wine and spirits. Patrons receive a tasting glass and product sample tickets as part of their admission cost. Patrons then choose which vendors and products they wish to sample. Additional sample tickets are sold during the event. While enjoying your choice of food and refreshment there will be local musical talent in the background.

In the first year of the event the organizers raised \$3000 for the Huron Residential Hospice. Once again, the hospice has been designated as the receiving charity for 2022.
